I have a love/hate relationship with Lent.

Many of you already know at least some of the basics of this season of the church year:

- Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which this year fell last month, on February 22nd.
- Lent lasts for forty days. This is based on the forty days' of Jesus' time in the wilderness, when he was tempted by the devil. [Rumors that it is based on the average length of one of Pastor Martin's sermons, though admittedly plausible-sounding, are in fact incorrect.]
- Sundays are technically NOT included in the forty days of Lent, meaning that the 40 days ends up lasting about six-and-a-half weeks. [6 1/2 wks. X 7 days per wk.= 45 1/2 days.. I guess math was different centuries ago when they came up with Lent.]
- Many Christians engage in the 'Lenten Discipline' of "giving something up for Lent". In our time and place, this 'something' is often sweets.
- Since Sundays are technically NOT included in the forty days of Lent (see third bullet, above), many Christians who are aware of this loophole spend Lenten Sundays pigging out on the sweets (see the fourth bullet, above) or otherwise indulging in whatever it is they are "giving up" with a clear conscience, thereby becoming poster-children for the truth of the old adage that "a little knowledge is a dangerous thing". [After all, if we're giving it up in part for health reasons, and it's unhealthy Monday-Saturday... For that matter, wouldn't it also be unhealthy during Easter, or Christmas, or any of the other seasons of the church year? Perhaps, in addition to math, the laws of medicine and nutrition were also different centuries ago when they came up with Lent.]
- Christian clergy typically try to encourage parishioners to not only "give something up for Lent", but to "take something on" as part of their Lenten discipline as well. These things that we are encouraged to take on for Lent can include extra time in prayer and Bible reading, renewed faithfulness in worship, extra giving to help the needy, etc. (Please see the Buck-a-Chick opportunity later in this newsletter, which invites us to contribute to purchase farm animals for needy villages throughout the world - a life-saving gift that can be really fun to give!) Admittedly, these calls to "take something on" can sometimes have what can be politely termed "**mixed results**".
- Christian churches have special gatherings on Wednesdays during Lent. These typically include a soup supper or some other **HUGE, DELICIOUS, ALL-YOU-CAN-EAT meal** [is anyone else noticing the... let's call it...'**irony**' in a season in which we are supposedly trying to **fast** and "**giving something up**"?], followed by some kind of Lenten devotions or worship that the pastor thinks every year will be utterly **fascinating**, but parishioners occasionally do **not** share that opinion. [Shocking, I know!]
- Lent ends with Easter Sunday, when we celebrate Jesus' resurrection from the dead, thereby defeating death and offering eternal life and salvation to all the world, and stuff like that. [Almost as shockingly as with the news in the bullet immediately preceding this one, the Easter Bunny does NOT figure prominently in any of

- Christians celebrate this joyful good news by living lives that proclaim with word and deed the victory of God’s life and love. [Either that, or we “take back on” the stuff we had been trying to give up throughout the forty days of Lent - and with great success, at least for the first 3 hours and 26 minutes of it - and by “giving up” all semblance of ‘Lenten discipline’.]

I hope you got at least a couple of laughs reading that first page - I enjoyed writing it!

But like I said, there’s kind of a love/hate relationship with Lent going on inside my head.

There certainly are some less than great things about Lent and Holy Week: especially for church workers it can get crazy-busy, and sometimes I wonder if we aren’t merely going through the Lenten motions rather than truly growing spiritually.

But I also love Lent. Our foibles can rightly be lampooned, but any extra time we are willing to devote to faith and fellowship is a wonderful thing. During Lent, it actually seems to get easier to speak honestly and openly about sin, grace and discipleship. Check out our Saturday School’s Bucks-for-a Chicks program, go ahead and “give something up” (and, yes, also use that extra time or extra money to “take something on” for Lent), join us for soup and devotions, reflect on what it means that you are baptized as a child of God and called to both discipleship and cross-carrying.

Perhaps you can tell... for me the love for Lent is a lot stronger! Take advantage of this time to grow in faith and closeness to God, God’s way and God’s call. If nothing else, truly ponder the cross - Christ loved you (and absolutely everyone) so much he was even willing to go through that. There is nothing in all the universe as great or strong as the love that led him to that cross.

Live in that love. Share that love.

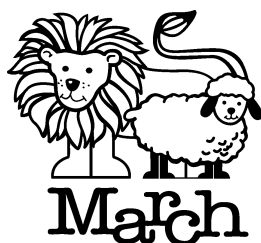
